3. Commentary

A new online Coronavirus Status Checker has been launched to help the NHS build up additional data on the COVID-19 response. It is in the form of a survey and asks individuals to answer a number of questions about their coronavirus experience. A weblink to the survey is at 1B. It is simple to complete and everyone is urged to take part.

The Coronavirus Status Checker asks:

- why you are staying at home
- to choose from a series of options to describe how you are feeling
- whether you have any other health problems
- your date of birth
- your postcode
- how many people are living in your home.

Fourteen bogus medical products being sold through unauthorised websites claiming to treat or prevent COVID-19 are being investigated by the Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency (MHRA).
