D. Commentary

The 5pm ministerial briefing was led by the Business Secretary, [Alok Sharma](#), who described the government's continuing work to re-open the UK's economy. He announced that the government was satisfied that its 'five tests' before easing restrictions were continuing to be met and the R rate (of virus transmission) remains below one. On that basis all retail outlets which have been required to remain closed will be able to open again from Monday 15th June 2020, providing they comply with the [COVID-secure guidelines](#) which were published on 25th May 2020.

Any business that re-opens must first complete a COVID-19 specific risk assessment and take the necessary steps to manage identified risks which is their legal obligation. They must also display a [notice](#) visibly in their shop windows or outside their store to show their employees, customers and other visitors that they have followed this guidance.

The government published an [explanatory note](#) about the Adult Social Care Infection Control Fund. The Adult Social Care Infection Control Fund is to support adult social care providers, including those with whom the local authority does not have a contract, to reduce the rate of COVID-19 transmission in and between care homes and support wider workforce resilience.

The document has been prepared in response to a number of questions received from local government and care providers.

5 tests for adjusting the lockdown

- 1** Protect the NHS's ability to cope. We must be confident that we are **able to provide sufficient critical care and specialist treatment** right across the UK.
- 2** See a **sustained and consistent fall in the daily death rates** from COVID-19 so we are confident that we have moved beyond the peak.
- 3** Reliable data from SAGE showing that **the rate of infection is decreasing to manageable levels** across the board.
- 4** Be confident that **the range of operational challenges, including testing capacity and PPE, are in hand**, with supply able to meet future demand.
- 5** Be confident that any **adjustments to the current measures will not risk a second peak of infections** that overwhelms the NHS.
