D. Commentary

The 5pm ministerial briefing was led by the Health and Social Care Secretary, Matt Hancock. He referred to the weekly surveillance report from Public Health England that shows that last week, for the first week since mid-March, the number of people who died in the UK from COVID-19 or anything else, was no higher than is normal at this time of year.

Mr Hancock gave updates on two key areas, **vaccines** and **NHS test and Trace**.

Vaccines

The vaccine under development by [Imperial College London](#) is now in the first phase of human clinical trials and the pharmaceutical company, [AstraZeneca](#), has started manufacturing the [University of Oxford vaccine](#) ahead of formal UK government approval so that a stockpile can be amassed in readiness for use.

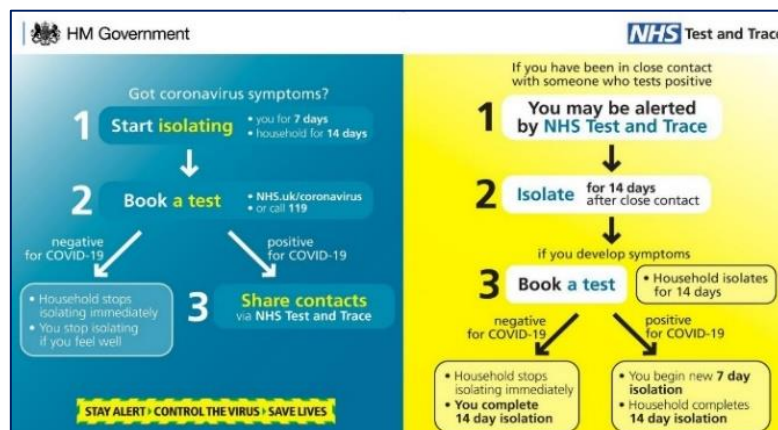
The [Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation](#) published its [interim advice](#) to government on how it should prioritise who should be vaccinated – if and when one becomes available. There are two groups recommended:

- Frontline health and social care workers; and
- Those at increased risk of serious disease and death from COVID-19 – for example adults over the age of 50 and those with heart and kidney disease.

NHS Test and Trace

Mr Hancock pointed out that the government considered the system is ‘working well’ and improving and thousands are now isolating as a result of being contacted through the programme. He explained that the complementary contact tracing app which has been tested in the Isle of Wight and in field trials has experienced a ‘technical barrier’ and will not work as originally anticipated. The government is now joining forces with Google and Apple to find a solution that works effectively across the UK.

The Health Secretary issued a reminder to anyone who receives a call or message from the [NHS Test and Trace service](#) to comply with their requests.
